

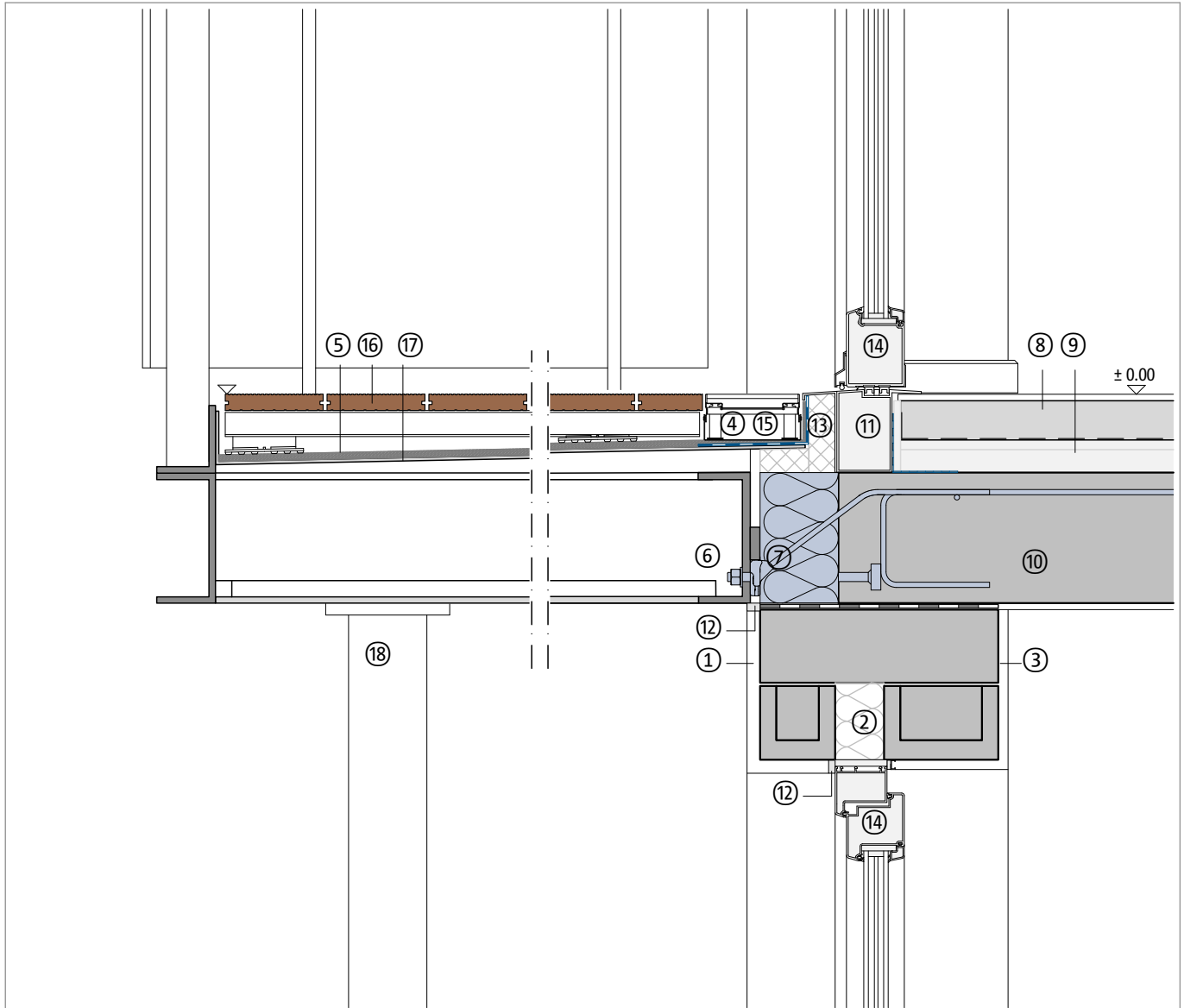

①	Exterior plaster
②	Brick lintel, thermally separated
③	Interior plaster
④	Insulation
⑤	Drain mat, optional
⑥	Head plate with cleat
⑦	Schöck Isokorb® XT type SQ
⑧	Floor covering, floating screed
⑨	Impact sound and thermal insulation

Component, example	
⑩	Reinforced concrete ceiling
⑪	Threshold, thermally insulated
⑫	Plastering profile or elastic joint
⑬	Thermal insulation, pressure-resistant (XPS)
⑭	Window element, door element
⑮	Facade channel
⑯	Wooden floorboards, substructure, support system
⑰	Sloped aluminum tray
⑱	Steel support with corrosion protection
